

Universiti Brunei Darussalam-ERIA-Harvard Symposium "SME Development and Innovation towards a 'People-Centred' ASEAN Community"

Venue: Senate Room, Chancellor Hall, Universiti Brunei Darussalam Date: 14th September 2013

Background Note and Program

At the 22nd ASEAN Summit, the leaders recognised that foster small and medium enterprises (SMEs) is critical to create job opportunities and promote social safety nets, in line with the goal to narrowing development gaps in the region. They encouraged ASEAN Member States (AMSs) and business organisations to look into ways to provide a strategic regional platform for long-term SME development cooperation, to empower SMEs, through training, advisory and financial support, to take advantage of ASEAN integration efforts.

This proposal for a one-day Symposium meant to discuss and articulate to the public a number of key issues on "SME Development and Innovation towards a People-Centred ASEAN Community", moving the ASEAN Community forward into 2015 and beyond, addressing the following key elements:

- (1) accelerating ASEAN economic community building
- (2) ensuring an equitable, people-centred, stable and robust growth of ASEAN
- (3) enhancing innovation and technology capability toward a competitive ASEAN SMEs

The ideas, insights, and recommendations from the presentations and discussions in the Symposium will be consolidated into a document entitled, "SME Development and Innovation towards a People-Centred ASEAN Community" to form part of the policy platform in response to the ASEAN aspiration for "Our People, Our Future Together", with an emphasis on the role of people in ASEAN's community building efforts and the future of ASEAN beyond 2015.

It is hoped that the deliberation of the Symposium could be presented formally to the ASEAN Heads of State by the ASEAN Secretary General and the Executive Director of ERIA during the ASEAN Summit in Bandar Seri Begawan in October 2013.
