Job Title: Energy Expert

Job Duties

1. Under broad direction of the Governing Board and Executive Director, undertake analytical and quantitative policy-oriented work and make policy recommendations on the topics in the field of energy and environment under the ERIA's working pillar of sustainable development within East Asia.
2. Manage research projects in the field of energy and environment undertaken by researchers, experts and consultants contracted by the ERIA.
3. Liaise with the government officials, business representatives and international organizations within East Asia as well as other relevant organizations. Attend meetings workshops and symposiums, and represent the ERIA as required.
4. Give lectures to the government officials.
5. Supervise subordinate staff as required.
6. Any other related duties as assigned by the ERIA Executive Director and Managing Director for Research Affairs.

Qualifications

1. Education and experience
 - Ph. D or equivalent in International Economics, Development Economics, Econometrics, Energy Economics, Environmental Economics, Transport Economics, Political Economy of Economic Integration, or a related field. Outstanding achievement of analytical works in the above-mentioned area can be evaluated as equivalent to Ph. D, thus entitled to apply.
 - 5 to 10 years' experience in the above fields or equivalent, especially in the field of energy and environment, that can be proved by the record of publishing in professional or academic journals, edited volumes or other established publications.
 - Have a perspective of making practical policy recommendations.

2. Key competencies

- Strong and proven capacity for analytical and policy- & business-oriented work; demonstrated ability to organize and conduct high quality original study projects and synthesize complex information and issues, including on concrete cases, for discussion at the intergovernmental level and to a standard suitable for publication.
- Capacity to adapt and to take initiatives. Proven ability to carry out several projects in parallel and to work under pressure, often to tight deadlines; ability to co-operate efficiently with staffs in the ERIA Secretariat, the researchers of other institutions, business people, and government officials within the region.
