Speech of Prime Minister of Japan, H.E. Mr. Yukio Hatoyama

Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen, Good afternoon.

But by building cooperation among each other, each entity and party on earth can benefit from such joint efforts.

I clearly believe that it is tremendously important to strengthen such ties and bonds in trade, economy, finance, computer, energy, science & technology, disaster mitigation and prevention, environment, medical services, diseases, education and culture. It is important to enhance cooperation in all these possible sectors to benefit all the people not just in the region but people all over the world.

His Excellency Dr. Surin has to go through much effort to create ERIA's activities that will be of key interest to the people. We share the opportunity to strengthen ERIA's activities in the world and its contribution to the world. All the world communities are facing with difficulties. These are not good news but because of the difficulties that we face on a global basis, the driving force of Asia and its growth would be a key driving force for us to be able to demonstrate our capability that will forge a path and to reach out and overcome any difficulty that we are facing.

I hope the East Asian Community initiative would become a much closer idea to us, and not only stay as a dream. I would like to extend my official appreciation to all the efforts that have been undertaken. I hope that this Symposium would be a significant collective one with the strong leadership of His Excellency Dr. Surin.
